Phonic Decoding - Break the words into their phonic components, then into onsets and sounds, explaining how 'jay', 'way' share a common Sound of '..ay '


Long Vowel: 'a' as in 'way'

Whole Words: 'the', 'on'



He met Tom on the way to play.









Jay and Tom went to play in the hay.






Jay and Tom met a dog on the way.




Jay, Tom and the dog all went to play.
